

## Construction Update



*The new eastbound Armour Road on-ramp to southbound I-29/35 is open! The off-ramp from southbound I-29/35 to eastbound and westbound Armour Road is also open. All other ramps in this intersection are under construction and scheduled to be complete by the end of the year.*



*The southbound I-29/35 ramp from 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Linn Street intersection will close soon after the southbound Bedford Avenue and Levee Road ramps open in the next few weeks. This area will no longer be a signed detour route. Once closed, work will begin to construct a new southbound I-29/35 bridge over 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue.*



*Median work in the 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue area stretches along the middle of the interstate between Armour Road and Bedford Avenue. This widening work is moving quickly, and traffic will be switched to the new pavement in this area soon.*



*Paving work has begun on the collector/distributor ramp between Bedford Avenue and Levee Road. These southbound ramps are scheduled to open in mid-July.*

*Work continues on the single-point urban interchange at I-29/35 and Front Street. Traffic is scheduled to be back on the mainline interstate (and off the temporary ramps) by Fall 2010.*



*Missouri's three longest concrete bridge girders were recently set in place for the Paseo Boulevard off-ramp, near Independence Avenue. Each girder weighs approximately 150,000 pounds and is around 150 feet long.*
