Armour Road southbound off-ramp, on-ramp to both close Tuesday, June 10



What: The westbound Armour Road off-ramp from southbound I-29/35 and the westbound Armour Road on-ramp to southbound I-29/35 will both close.

When: Tuesday, June 10, 2008. The southbound off-ramp is scheduled to reopen in about one year. The westbound Armour Road to southbound I-29/35 on-ramp will remain closed while bridge widening work is done on the highway over Armour Road. This on-ramp is scheduled to reopen in late 2009.

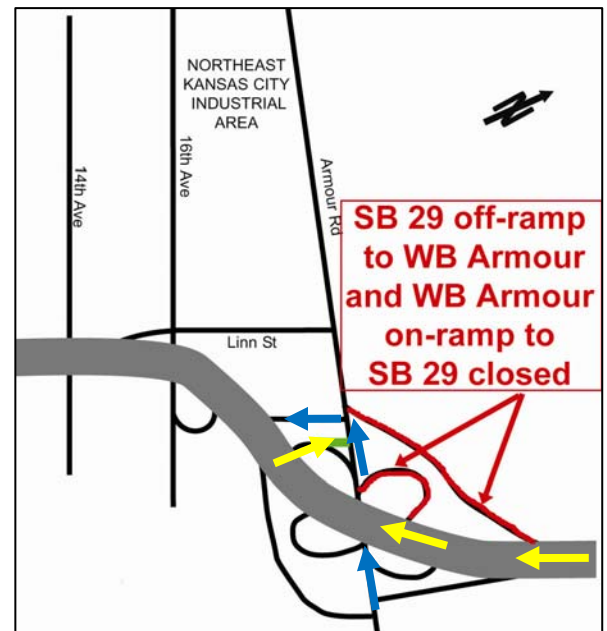
Why: Both ramps will be reconstructed, a new traffic signal installed to control the movements of traffic exiting from southbound I-29/35 onto Armour Road and retaining walls built along the outside of the off-ramp.

When this off-ramp reconstruction work is complete next year, all southbound I-29/35 motorists will use the same off-ramp to access westbound Armour Road or eastbound Route 210. The existing loop ramp that takes southbound highway motorists onto eastbound Route 210 will be permanently eliminated, and the traffic signal at the end of the new Armour Road southbound off-ramp will control left turns onto eastbound Route 210.

Alternate Routes:

Alternate route for closure of SB I-29/35 off-ramp to WB Armour
Southbound I-29/35 motorists wanting to go west on Armour Road should exit onto the eastbound Armour Road loop ramp. Temporary turn lanes and a traffic signal will be in place to permit left turns onto westbound Armour Road.

Alternate route for closure of WB Armour to SB I-29/35 on-ramp
Westbound Armour Road motorists wanting to go south on I-29/35 should use the same ramp that currently exists for access to the highway from eastbound Armour Road. A temporary traffic signal will be installed along Armour Road to permit left turns onto the existing ramp.



While the westbound Armour Road off-ramp from southbound I-29/35 is closed, **alternate routes are strongly advised.** Rather than using I-29/35 to access Armour Road, I-35 motorists are encouraged to go south on Chouteau Trafficway or Antioch Road and it is suggested that I-29 motorists go south on Highway 169 or North Oak Trafficway to get to Armour Road (see map on reverse side).
